ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2019-06

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING USE OF WATER FACILITIES

The owner of all houses, buildings, or properties situated within the Village and abutting on any street, alley, or right of way in which there is now located a public water main, shall be required to make connection to the public water main within 200 days after official notice that the water main is available. The owner shall pay all costs of connection, including recapture fees, if applicable.

The owner of all houses, buildings, or properties situated within the Village and abutting on any street, alley, or right of way in which a public water main is within 300 feet of the nearest property line of the property shall be required to extend the public water main to and across the frontage of the property and make connection as herein provided. If such water main extension benefits other properties, the Village shall enact a recapture ordinance and make best efforts to collect and return to the owner amounts received from benefited properties.

After connection to the public water supply, the private water supply shall be physically disconnected from the building water piping connected to the public water supply.

Penalty: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine and all costs related to connections to the public water supply and court costs. The fine structure is as follows:

1st Offense: \$180.00

2nd Offense-committed within 12 months of any prior offense: \$330.00

3rd Offense-committed within 12 months of any prior offense: \$580.00

Severability: If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or under any circumstances is adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or of any portion not adjudged invalid.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
